

**LOCAL RULES AS OF 01/08/07
PLEASE LEVEL OUT FOOTPRINTS IN BUNKERS
REPLACE DIVOTS & PITCHMARKS**

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- Hole 1 A ball beyond the service road to the right side of the fairway.
Hole 2 From the tee, a ball, on or beyond the 3rd fairway, refer to marked trees.
Hole 5 A ball beyond (any Out of Bounds markers at) the top of the mounding to the right side of the fairway
Hole 6 A ball past the ditch on the 8th fairway.
A ball beyond the service road or on the mounding to the right side of the fairway
Hole 9 From the tee a ball on or beyond the 12th fairway.
Hole 12 A ball on the 14th fairway beyond the water hazard.
Hole 13 A ball on the 14th fairway but not including the 14th tee area.
Hole 18 Any ball on the 10th fairway up to and including the ditch in front of the 10th tee area.
Any ball beyond the trunks of the Fir trees on the right hand side of the fairway.
A ball beyond any Out of Bound markers surrounding the green.

OVER ALL BOUNDARY FENCES AND HEDGES INCLUDING DRIVING RANGE ENCLOSURE.

2. STAKED AND YOUNG TREES

A free drop is allowed if it interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing to the nearest point of relief plus one club length but no nearer the hole. (Rule 24-26)

3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

A ball lying on ground under repair, or on any tee or putting area other than that of the hole being played MUST be lifted and dropped clear, but no nearer the hole without penalty.

4. OLD HOLE REPAIR

Any ball lying on a putting green may be moved without penalty, not nearer the hole in order that any old repair does not impair the intended putting line.

5. BARE PATCH

A ball lying in a bare patch on the fairway, or in a crack in the fairway caused by dry weather may be lifted and dropped without penalty behind such bare patch or crack. (Not a divot)

6. VANDALISM

Where obvious vandalism has taken place, appropriate relief may be taken without penalty.

7. SPRINKLER HEADS

If a sprinkler head lies along the player's intended line of play or interferes with his stance, the ball may be lifted and dropped without penalty, one club length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.

8. GENERAL PLAY

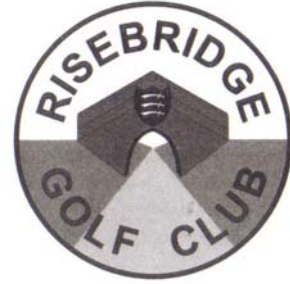
- a) A ball coming to rest on or beside marker boxes, concrete markers or tee areas of kerbstones may be lifted and dropped without penalty.
b) Cans and bottles may be removed without penalty from hazards providing the ball does not move.
c) A ball lying on any path or crossing may be lifted and dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.
d) A ball may be teed up 2 club lengths either way of the competition tees.
e) If a ball comes to rest near any marker stakes and it interferes with stance, swing or intended line of play, it may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point, no nearer the hole.
g) A ball lying in a drainage rut in the fairway or rough may be dropped, without penalty, at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole
f) Stones and loose impediments in bunkers are moveable obstructions. (Rule 24-1)

9. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

Parallel with course, Holes: 2,5,6,8,9,10,14,15,16,17 & 18. Drop within 2 club lengths at point of entry either side but no nearer the hole. All other ditches are water hazards.
